## Monochrome Definitions

After doing a bit of research on the internet I have discovered that the world wide standard definition for Monochrome Prints is the FIAP or International Federation of Photographic Art . The FCC is now using these definitions and so are we. Below are two definitions – the first from FIAP and the second from APS – both saying the same thing in different words.

- **Monochrome** - (FIAP Definition) "A black and white work fitting from the very dark grey (black) to the very clear grey (white) is a monochrome work with the various shades of grey. A black and white work toned entirely in a single colour will remain a monochrome work able to stand in the black and white category. On the other hand a black and white work modified by partial toning or by the addition of one colour becomes a colour work (polychrome) to stand in the colour category."

- (APS) "Any photograph containing shades of only one colour. If toning is carried out, it must be over the total photograph – partial toning and / or the addition on one extra colour is not acceptable in a monochrome section ."

I should mention too that it is not up to guest judges what is an acceptable entry to our club and it is up the competition secretaries to decide if a photograph does not follow our rules

The FCC Interclub was held last weekend at Canterbury Bankstown LC and BCPC won the colour prints section of for small clubs. More involvement next year would be nice to take us out of the small club category with a chance of winning one of the trophies.
