<b>What is there</b>	<p><b>CATHEDRAL ROCKS</b> a distinctive rock formation</p> <p><b>BOMBO HEADLANDS</b> An unusual basalt wall and columns quarried in the 1880 &amp; 1900s</p> <p><b>SPRING CREEK BIRD HIDE</b> The observation hide enables a close up view of water birds</p> <p><b>TERRACE &amp; SANDSTONE SHOPS</b>, Originally homes for the local quarrymen.</p> <p><b>KIAMA BLOWHOLE</b> – the water spout shoots up to 60 metres. The site Includes a Lighthouse, Pilots House &amp; Kiama harbour</p> <p><b>BONAIRA NATIVE GARDENS</b> tranquil place with an established rainforest dedicated to the Wadi Wadi People</p> <p><b>KIAMA'S DRY STONE WALLS</b>: 400 stone wall constructed over 100year ago</p>	
<b>Amenities</b>	A Pit Stop will be made on the trip down and we can grab some Brekkie. Lunch at the Terrace shops	
<b>Costs</b>	<b>\$15.00 per person for petrol.</b> Brekky & Lunch is at your pleasure.	
<b>Date &amp; Time</b>	<b>8<sup>th</sup> November 08</b> <b>Leaving 7.00am (SHARP) arriving at our first shoot at approximately 9am</b> <b>Leaving Kiama at 5.30</b>

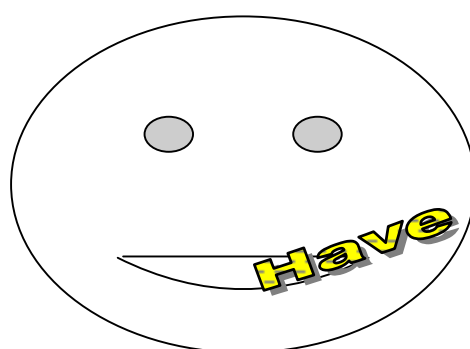
## South Coast Day Trip - November 08
